1.- Plot Summary

He is obsessed with the purist defense of the law, while she is more concerned with the motives behind human behavior and, above all, women's rights. Their relationship begins to stagger when Adam accepts the Attingers' case and soon after learns that he will have to face his client's wife, defense attorney Doris Attinger (Judy Holliday). Doris had burst into the apartment where her husband was meeting with a lover and, in a fit of hysteria, shoots them.

2.- Themes to discuss

Adam and Amanda, once they overcome the difficulties that almost lead them to separate, look back on everything they have experienced. Amanda sustains that men and women are the same; Adam "almost" agrees. It's true that we are equal in dignity, but there are differences between men and women. As little as these differences may be, they configure us as people. We know today that men and women are 97% biologically identical, and this is found in every one of our cells. In other words, we are practically the same and, at the same time, different in every way. As Adam says, "Long live differences!"

1.- Plot Summary

2.- Themes to discuss

This short film uses comedy to deal with the topic of a boy being attracted to a girl. The difference seem here is captured in his different modes of thinking. Even though it is done in a surely limited way that tends toward materialism, what we see is the need to integrate the different factors that make up the person that we are. Affectivity cannot be separated from rationality, and rationality must be united to the will. To integrate our actions is to know how to harmonize these dimensions that, if separated from one another, don't provide us with the key of how to get to know ourselves better.

Oftentimes today the love between a man and a woman remains at this initial stage; it does not evolve or mature, and therefore it ends up breaking.
